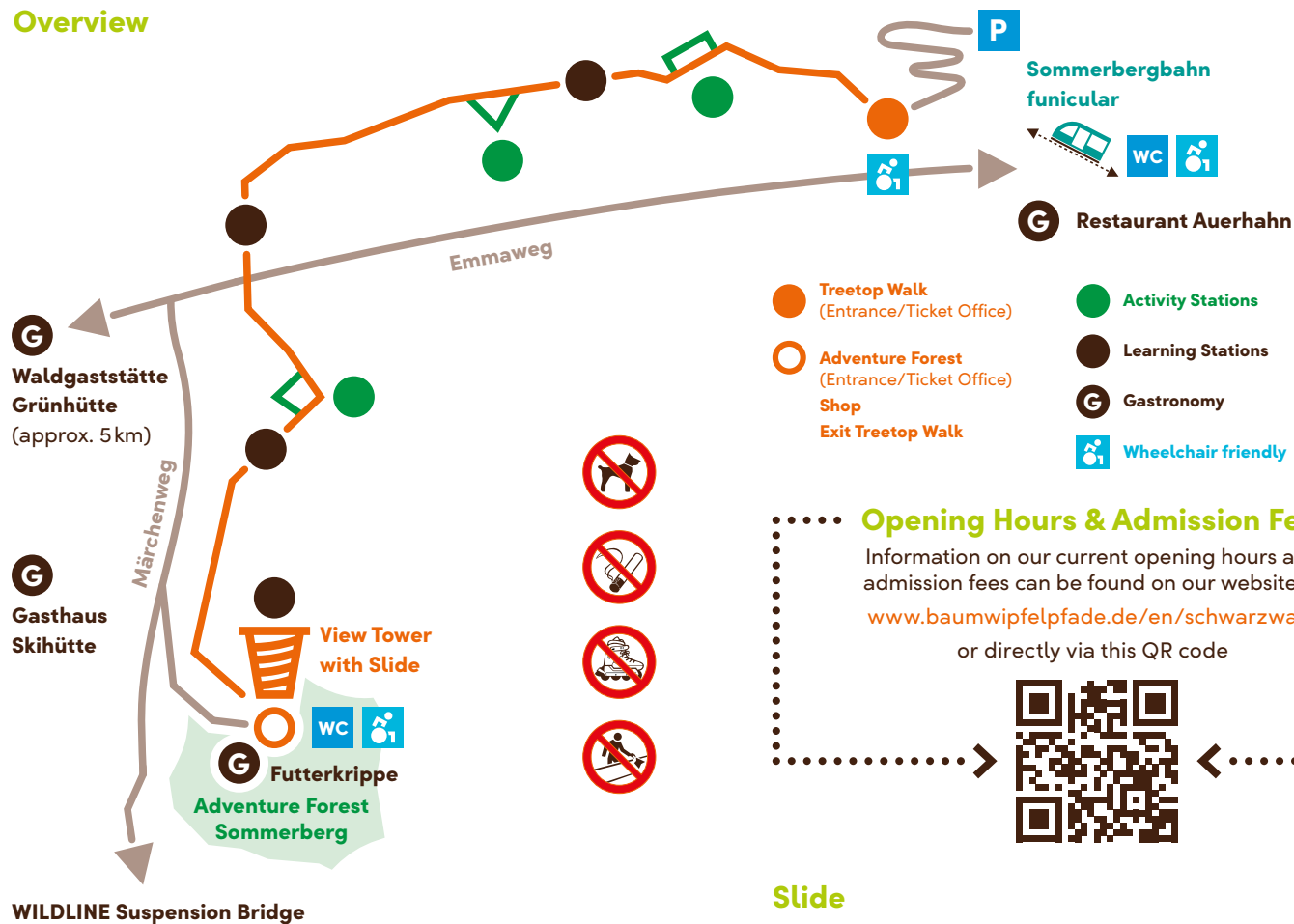

Seasonal operation: expected from April to early November. Info about the operating hours can be found on our homepage.

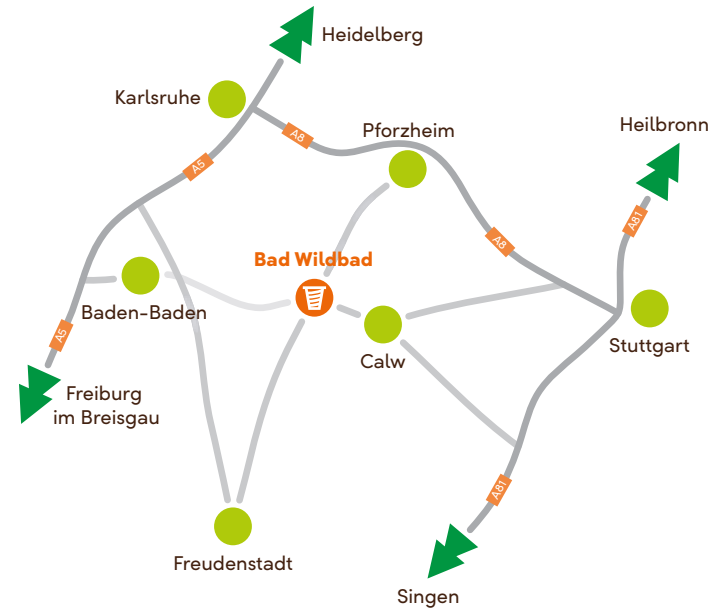
Parking

We recommend using one of the signposted multi-storey car parks in Bad Wildbad. Each is within easy walking distance of the Sommerbergbahn, which will take you directly to the treetop walk. As an alternative, there is pay parking on the Sommerberg itself. Thanks to the parking direction system, the car parks and the parking area on the Sommerberg are easy to find. Extra parking is available at the sports field in Bad Wildbad.

Sommerbergbahn

The Sommerbergbahn, Baden-Württemberg's highest funicular, has connected Bad Wildbad's center with the Sommerberg for over 100 years. The modern wagons with panoramic roofs allow visitors a magnificent view of the city. The Sommerbergbahn takes visitors quickly and comfortably up the mountain.

Arrival

We recommend travelling with the tram S6 from Pforzheim. The Uhlandplatz (Sommerbergbahn) stop is right by the funicular valley station. Weather Conditions

In case of thunderstorms, high winds, hail and ice, the treetop walk may be closed to visitors for safety reasons. Depending on weather conditions, the slide may be closed at short notice. Please refer to the Visitors' Rules.

Please Note

Bicycles, scooters etc. are not permitted on the walkway.

Dogs & Pets

Dogs (and animals of all kinds) aren't permitted on the treetop walk. Exception: Disabled companion and assistance dogs.

Discover and Experience the Treetop Walk

With a total length of 1,250 meters (including the ramp in the tower) and a height of up to 20 meters above the forest floor, the walkway winds its way through the beech trees, firs and spruces of the impressive mixed mountain woodland, passing numerous learning stations which present interesting facts about the indigenous flora and fauna.

Wheelchair Friendly

The treetop walk and the tower ramp have a maximum gradient of 6 %, making them easy to use with wheelchairs and prams alike. The wire fencing of the railing grants a free view of the surroundings even from a seated position. The Sommerbergbahn and many of the restaurants are also designed wheelchair friendly. Wheelchairs and wheeled walkers can be borrowed free of charge at the entrance.

Family Friendly

Our treetop walk is a great place to spend the day with the whole family – thanks to our activity and adventure stations and our family tickets.

Close to the exit of the treetop walk you can find the fairy tale path “The cold heart”, adapted from Wilhelm Hauffs fairytale “Heart of stone”.

View Tower

The highlight of the walkway is the view tower, which is 40 meters high. It has a ring of main supports which simultaneously lean outwards and counterclockwise, and its exceptional architecture gives it the appearance of an enormous beaker. Despite its unusual appearance, the tower is delicately integrated into the surrounding natural landscape.

Once you reach the platform of the view tower, you are rewarded with a unique 360 degree view of the Black Forest landscape – up to the Swabian Alb, the Kraichgau and even the Stuttgart television tower.

The 55-meter tunnel slide inside the tower is great fun for anyone.

Shop

At our shop at the tower exit you can find regional specialties, sustainable products – made from wood, felt and other materials – and all sorts of souvenirs.

Group Offers & Events

On a guided tour of the treetop walk you will learn about the flora and fauna of the Northern Black Forest, and receive first-hand information about the numbers, data and facts concerning the treetop walk.
